Gateway 180's vision to end family homelessness in the St. Louis community is only possible with a wide network of partners and resources working together.




In 2018, we served 997 clients, 54% of whom were children.




Gateway 180 relies on people for their gifts of time, treasure, and talent, and we make sure we're good stewards of these gifts that are shared with us.



Persons Served




Amount of Persons Placed in Housing







2018 Operation Revenues


